



Age Level Classes for 2023-2024

Turtle 2s - Two class options for two-year-olds taught by **Miss Kathryn:**

- Monday/ Wednesday- 9-11 a.m.
- Tuesday/ Thursday- 9-11 a.m.

Turtles is a faith-based, hands-on class that provides a safe and loving environment for our students. This class focuses on learning self-help skills, making choices, following routines, learning to separate from caregivers, following single step directions, being exposed to diverse vocabulary, exploring new things, being able to communicate as their language skills begin to blossom, lots of sensory experiences and learning about Jesus' love for them. We foster excitement for school, while setting the stage for emotional growth and future independence.

Children must be 2 by September 1 of the current school year. The student/teacher ratio is 4:1 with a maximum number of 8 students per class. Students do not need to be potty trained.

Ladybug 3s- Two class options for three-year-olds taught by **Miss Kim:**

- Monday/ Wednesday/ Friday- 9-11:30 a.m.
- Tuesday/ Thursday- 9-11:30 a.m.

In Ladybug classes, students are taught how to become independent in classroom routines and develop self-control. They learn how to play with friends and how to communicate their thoughts with classmates and teachers. Children are introduced to numbers, counting, and number patterns. They become familiar with letters, focusing specifically on the letters that make up their name. Opposite pairs are introduced in an environment that is rich in vocabulary. Students sing, dance, listen to stories, and have lots of fun while learning developmentally appropriate content in a hands-on/play based classroom. Additionally, they are taught about God's truths and His world.

Children must be 3 by September 1 of the current school year. Students must be starting toilet training and wear a pull-up if they are still in the learning process. The student/teacher ratio is 6:1 with a maximum number of 12 students per class.

- Froglet 4s 5-day Pre-K taught by **Miss Lauren**: Monday- Friday- **8:30-11:30 a.m.**
- Bee 4s 3-day taught by **Miss Mandy**: Monday/ Wednesday/ Friday- 9-11:30 a.m.
- Bee 4s 2-day taught by **Miss Mandy**: Tuesday/ Thursday- 9 a.m. -2 p.m. (Includes lunch)


Our **5-day Froglet Pre-K Class** with Miss Lauren provides the routine of five consecutive days, which will help your child be well adjusted and prepared for a 5 day/ full day kindergarten class the following year. The class is three hours long from 8:30 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. These three hours, five days a week allow for the consistency of skill development and provide additional time for reinforcement and one on one teacher support. Social and emotional learning is taught and practiced daily, which will help students gain confidence. The increased time also allows for more parent involvement. Monthly activities and events are held for parents/caregivers to come into the classroom and experience pre-k through the eyes of their child. This class adapts to the children and focuses on their interests as well as their ideas. Children can explore unique centers for writing, art, and STEM activities, as well as enjoy the fun of *Catch of the Day!* The beauty of this class is more time for learning and more time for fun. Lunch Llamas and Imagination Station can be added to further enhance the day.

All our four-year-old classes focus on kindergarten readiness by providing a hands-on, play driven, loving, and an engaging environment. Children learn how to independently carry out routines, develop and strengthen a proper pencil grip, communicate not only their wants and needs, but also their thoughts, ideas, questions, and predictions. Social emotional skills are an important focus. Children learn to identify and manage their feelings, how to problem solve, have empathy for others, and learn coping skills for real life scenarios. Children are introduced to various science topics about the world around them. They explore books daily and focus on pre-reading skills such as letter recognition, phonics/phonemes (letter sounds-blending sounds), rhyming, syllabication, and word families to name a few. Math content includes counting, patterns, classification/sorting, one to one correspondence, comparing, measurement, and so much more. They are one step away from kindergarten and these classes are the key to your child's success. In the four-year-old classes, your child will gain a deeper understanding of who God is and how to have a relationship with Jesus too!

Children must be 4 by September 1 of the current school year. Students must be **completely** toilet trained, wearing underwear daily. The student/teacher ratio is 8:1 with a maximum number of 16 students per class.






AFTERNOON ADD-ON CLASSES

Lunch Llama 3s & 4s- Monday- Friday-11:30 a.m. -12:30 p.m. 

This class provides time for lunch and socialization, along with games and activities that promote exercise, health, wellness, an understanding about the food they eat and more. Lunch is provided by families, and a brief lesson is taught as children eat. The second half hour provides gross motor play outside on our playground (weather permitting) or inside in our “big room.”

Story Explorers 3s & 4s – Tuesday/Thursday 12:30-2:00 p.m.   

This is an extended day class springboarding from literature. Students will listen to quality stories and respond to the story books through teacher directed activities including music, movement, gross motor activities, as well as art. Limited to 12 children.

This is an extended day class dedicated to the arts, which allows the children to bring their imaginations to life. Great for a child who loves to create, is artistic and/or has a vivid imagination. If children can imagine it, the teachers can help them to create it. Limited to 10 children.
